International Matches

Tournament in Holland

Kingston Little League recently sent a team to the European tournament in the Netherlands.

The KLL team took the opportunity to test their footballing skills against foreign opposition in two European competitions in their first trip abroad since 1983.

Held over the weekend of 22nd and 23rd April, the 11-a-side competition consisted of two sets of group matches, and each game was 15 minutes each way, played on a full sized pitch. The top two teams from each group would progress to the semi-finals. The penalty competition, held on the first afternoon, saw each team taking penalties against five other teams.

In the first game Kingston started the scoring having encamped in Untruth's half for most of the first period. at the start of the second half the Germans piled on the pressure and pulled back to level the scores at 1 - 1.

In response Kingston came straight back into the game and took control, and in pouring rain added two more goals to their tally.

Kingston again dominated against the Danish opposition, making great

use of the space available. Kingston's goal keeper had only long-range shots to deal with as the Danes could find no way through Kingston's solid defence.

Kingston now had to play Dutch side Verburch D1, but they had not yet arrived! The organisers put out their D2 team who sadly were no match for a Kingston team on the top of their form. As the final whistle blew, the news arrived that the D1 team had arrived and so another game was scheduled far later in the day.

When the game finally took place, it turned out to be the top-of-the-table clash! The Dutch had the early chances, but by half time Kingston had found its shape, especially in defence. Kingston's winning goal came late in the second half leaving them as group winners, and with the prospect of a semi-final against the home team!

Both the semi-finals and the final took place at the ground of home team RKVV Westlandia, a stadium not dissimilar to that of Kingsmeadow, home of top Conference side Kingstonian.

Kingston went ahead in the first half in what was their hardest game yet. During the second half the Dutch continued to play good, controlled football, making Kingston work hard for their fourth clean sheet of the tournament. But one goal was enough to see Kingston go through to the final.

Even with both teams creating good chances the first half ended goalless but four minutes into the second period, Blanc Mesnil took the lead. Kingston responded strongly looking for the equaliser but their final

touch had deserted them.

In the dying seconds Kingston were hit by a counter-attack which culminated in an unstoppable shot. 2-0 to Blanc and an exciting final ending in defeat for a tiring Kingston team.
